

Because of the dearth of educational options in the Vindhya area, renowned freedom warrior Captain / Pratap Singh made the decision to create a university. Darbar Intermediate College was upgraded to a deginary Captain Awadhesh Pratap Singh, the state's first prime minister following independence. His subsequativarious levels to build a university in Rewa were unsuccessful since the necessary procedures could not in his lifetime. His worthy son Govind Narayan Singh took over as the area's chief minister in 1967.

He was aware of his father's desire and looked through official records and the thirty lakh Rupees that were the university's founding. Later, he brought forward the idea of building Awadhesh Pratap Singh University to his ministerial council, and it was warmly received. About Rewa City

Rewa is renowned worldwide as the "land of white tigers," as the first white tiger was discovered here. Named Mohan by Maharaja Martand Singh, the ruling king, Mohan's descendants now reside across the globe. Rewa, situated on the central Vindhya Plateau, served as the capital of the Princely State of Rewa from the early 17th century A.D. The name "Rewa" is derived from 'Reva,' the ancient name of the sacred river Narmada. Rewa also had the distinction of being



the capital of Vindhya Pradesh. It is the only place globally where exquisite handicrafts are crafted from beetle nuts (supari), with finished works displaying impeccable craftsmanship where joints are imperceptible.

Presently, Rewa functions as a divisional headquarters and is a significant hub for education and culture in Central India. It boasts the distinction of housing the sole Sainik School in each state. This region is rapidly evolving into an industrial hub with the presence of industry giants such as NTPC, NCL, Jaypee Cement, ACC Cement, Prism Cement, and Birla Ericsson, along with multinational corporations like Essar Group, Reliance, KJS Cements, among



others. The establishment of one of the world's largest Solar Power Plants and the unique White Tiger Safari has transformed Rewa into a prominent center for energy and tourism in Madhya Pradesh and Central India. Four-lane road connectivity from Satna, Jabalpur, Allahabad, and Varanasi has accelerated business and commercial activities in Rewa. The commissioning of the Bansagar Dam Project and the rapid expansion of its canal network are poised to reshape the fortunes of this region.

The White Tiger Safari in Mukundpur (16 km, 30 min), Bandhavgarh (160 km, 3 hrs), and Khajuraho (200 km, 4 hrs) are nearby international tourism centers for wildlife and heritage tourism, respectively. Maihar (65 km, 90 min),

Chitrakoot (150 km, 3 hrs), and Vindhyavasini (250 km, 4 hrs 30 min) are sacred pilgrimage spots in this region.

Rewa is accessible by road from Satna, located 52 km away on the Howrah-Bombay route. It can also be reached via Prayagraj (125 km, 2 hrs) and Jabalpur (230 km, 3.5 hrs) through well-connected four-lane roads. Rewa enjoys excellent railway connectivity with 11 trains originating from here, connecting prominent cities and destinations such as New Delhi, Mumbai, Bhopal, Indore, Jabalpur, Bilaspur, Nagpur, Kevadia, and Rajkot.





Our University

This university was established on 20th July 1968 as a state university of Madhya Pradesh. The University has been named after a distinguished son of the soil and a freedom fighter Capt. Awadhesh Pratap Singh, a national leader and the first Prime Minister of Vindhya Pradesh. The university was recognized by the UGC in February 1972. The University is a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and All Commonwealth Association of Universities (ACAU). The University has 16 teaching departments and 12 Study Centres which offer more than 50 post graduate and under graduateprogrammes on regular and self-supporting basis. We also impart education through 239 affiliated colleges within the University jurisdiction in Anuppur, Rewa, Satna, Shahdol, Sidhi, Singrauli and Umaria districts of Madhya Pradesh. We have also started more than 30 Certificate Programmes for skill development of youth. Our university is producing world class talent with optimum utilization of limited resources. Under the dynamic leadership of our present Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Rajkumar Acharya the university has set new goals and aspirations for itself and is aiming to achieve greater heights.

University Campus

The university is spread over 258 acres of hilly and green campus. It is located about 3 kilometers to the north of the main city of Rewa on Sirmour Road. The university buildings include an Administrative Block, Departments of Environmental Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, and English, Humanities Block, Department of Psychology, Ambedkar Bhawan, Life Long Learning Department, Antar Bharti Building, Community Hall, Biotechnology ilding, Law and Commerce Building, Directorate of Distance Education Building, Department of Business Admir ation, Computer Centre, USIC Building, Library, Pt. Department of Ancient Indian History Culture & Archaeology

This department was established in September 1984 under the 6th Five-Year Plan. The number of teaching posts sanctioned in the department includes one professor, one reader, and three lecturers by the UGC. The department runs Ph.D. and M.A. (A.I.H.C. & Arch.) programs as regular programs, while the B.A. (Hons) program is offered as a Self-Supporting Programme (SSP). The department invites eminent professors from across the country to deliver Invited Talks to the students.



Our Attractions

- 1. Museum: Our museum was established in 1991 and houses a significant collection of rare fossils, prehistoric tools, pottery, paintings, excavated materials, and a unique cylindrical stupa with epigraphical and paleographical remains of the "Boudha" mantra and the "kalma" of Islam. A rare type of architectural and sculptural fragment is also preserved here. We have some original manuscripts in Sanskrit, Hindi, and Urdu script. Our museum is open to all.
- 2. Rich Departmental Library: The library contains about 6000 books, dissertations and thesis.

The Study Centre for Law was established in July 2004 when the BALLB program was started with the approval of the Bar Council of India, with an intake of 160 students. Later, the LLM program was also introduced at the study centre. Presently, around 800 students are receiving education in law from this study centre. A faculty of experienced, qualified, and young teachers is appointed per BCI norms to teach the students and prepare them for the legal profession. Many of our students have qualified for national and state-level exams and have become honorable justices in Madhya Pradesh and beyond. Many are serving in corporate houses as law officers and legal executives, and many have proved their potential as advocates at district and high courts. Every year, the centre celebrates Constitution Day and regularly holds Legal Aid Clinics and Moot Courts. Recently, a statue of Bharat Ratna B. R. Ambedkar has been established on the premises of the centre to motivate students to choose the legal profession to serve society and facilitate justice for people at the bottom of the pyramid.

Study Centre for Commerce

The Study Centre for Commerce was established in July 2012 with the aim of providing quality education at a reasonable cost to students in this region who aspire to make their careers in commerce, business, and management. The centre offers BCom and MCom programs in self-finance mode. This study centre is housed in a well-furnished building at the university, featuring seven lecture rooms, a library, and an auditorium for organizing academic and cultural activities. A faculty of young and dynamic teachers is appointed to teach the students and facilitate learning. The centre is launching BCom (Retail Operations Management) in collaboration with CRISP. Presently, there are around 500 students at the study centre. Our alumni are well-placed in government, banking sector, corporate world and as successful entrepreneurs.

Gandhian Study Centre: An Ancillary Unit of the Department

This centre was established during the 10th plan period under the able directorship of Prof. N.P. Pathak, Professor, Department of Business Economics. As the name suggests, the activities of this centre revolve around Gandhi's philosophy of truth, non-violence, and simple living. It organizes programs on occasions related to Mahatma Gandhi A series of 150 programs were celebrated from October 2nd, 2018 to October 2nd, 2019, by the Gandhian Study Centre under the canopy of the department. Various programs were held throughout the year on this occasion.

Various popular lectures were organized in different units of the department by inviting learned professors from various universities. The department also organizes many extracurricular activities, such as Welcome parties Farewell parties, Teacher's Day, and Birth Anniversary celebrations of great leaders like Mahatma Gandhi, Pt. Nehra Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, and Indira Gandhi.



Department of Chemistry

This department was established in 1984, with the basic aim of catering to the needs of students of Vindhya Region which is a socially and economically backward part of Central India. This region is particularly rich in natural resources. Our former Prime Minister (Late) Mrs. Indira Gandhi foresighted it as Cement Belt and planned to run "Cement Express" From Delhi to connect Power Capital to the Country "Shaktinagar" in the Singrauli area. Situated in border of UP & MP the region is rich in natural



resources like limestone, bauxite, coal, diamond, granite and iron etc. Based on these resources major industries like cement aluminum coal, (Power) and paper are operating since past fifty year. Chemical Sciences are the backbone of these major industries; Most of such industrial units are in the university jurisdiction. The department has been recognized by the UGC, New Delhi, for its academic pursuits, and special assistance under the DRS was sanctioned to the department in 2006. Despite abundant natural resources and manpower, the younger generation of the region lacked technical skills and the ability to exploit the available resources. Local stalwarts and academicians felt that with proper guidance, quality teaching, and technical know-how, this region could be developed and brought into the mainstream of the country. With these objectives, the then Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Hira Lal Nigam, a renowned inorganic chemist, made significant efforts to establish a Department of Chemistry at this university. Postgraduate teaching and research programs were undertaken by the department to fulfill its aims and goals.

The department has received major research projects from DST, CSIR, UGC, AICTE, MPCST etc. It was given DRS by the UGC in the year 2004. The department has an e-class room, Conference Hall and modern laboratories. Presently a MoU has been signed with MPCST, Bhopal (MP).

College of Pharmacy

In Madhya Pradesh, the need for Pharmacy education was increasingly felt with the rapid growthof thestate's pharmaceutical sector. As a result of these College of Pharmacy was established inAwadhesh Pratap Singh University, Rewa. B. Pharm degree course (4 Years) was started from the session2023-24 after getting permission from PCI New Delhi. From session 2024-25 PCI has increased theintake in B. Pharm 60 to 100 seats. PCI has also given the permission for D. Pharm course (60 seats). D.Pharm course is of two Years course.



Department of Computer Application

The department was established in 1985-86, formerly known as the Computer Centre, by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi, with the aim of providing job-oriented computer courses and employment-oriented programs to students from the Vindhya region. Initially, the department was headed by Prof. S.P. Agrawal, who played a crucial role in its firm establishment and development. Initially, an ICIM DRS 300 Mini Computer System was installed along with other peripheral devices, including line printers. The established computer centre was upgraded by the UGC in the year 2000. In 2017, the University renamed the Computer Centre as the Department of Computer Application.

Currently, the department has two computer labs equipped with the latest computers, printers, and other peripheral devices. The BCA program was started in the academic year 2006-2007 on a self-supporting basis (Ordinance number 120 program was student demand, the University initiated the Master of Computer Application (MCA) course in the academic year 2013-14 (Ordinance number 165). The MCA course received approval from AICTE, New Delhi, starting from the session 2015-16. In addition to these courses, the department offers 12 short-term computer course based on student demand (Ordinance number 95). As of the academic session 2020-21, there are 310 student enrolled in the department.

The Department of Computer Science was established in 1990 by the University Grants Commission (UGC) with the objective of imparting quality education in the field of Computer Science and serving the students of the Vindhya Region with job-oriented programs. The department ensures that its objectives are consistently met and learning outcomes are monitored through academic activities such as assignments, seminars, periodic tests, tutorials, and feedback. Control measures have been designed to ensure that the goals and objectives of the department has



objectives of the department keep pace with the local, national, and international scenarios.

The department offers PGDCA, BSc Hons (Computer Science), MSc (Computer Science), MTech (Computer Science), and PhD programs. The department is launching MSc (ICT), PG Diploma in Data Science and PG Diploma in Web Designing. The program structures adhere to the NEP 2020 in the CBCS pattern. Special Achievements:

Eleven students were selected as Assistant Professors in MPPSC 2018, and several others were selected as scientific officers in MPPSC 2017, with four scientists also recruited. Additionally, several students have qualified for UGC NET and CSIR exams.

This study centre was established in 1997 with the vision to provide teaching, practical, and research facilities in various fields of Biotechnology such as Human Genetics, Molecular Biology, Medical Biotechnology, Agricultural Biotechnology, Environmental Biotechnology, Industrial Biotechnology, and Recombinant DNA Technology. The department aims to popularize science and technology among higher secondary and high school students. Additionally, many events organized by this department have successfully spread knowledge and developed practical aptitude among rural and tribal students in the Vindhya region.

The department boasts excellent infrastructure with laboratories equipped with highly sophisticated instruments including Real Time PCR, Fermenter, UV-VIS Spectrophotometer, PCR Machine (Thermal Cycler), Deep freezer (-80°C), and Gel Documentation System. For training and placement of students, the department has signed MOUs with S.S.M.C. Rewa, Gennova Biopharmaceuticals Pune, NBFGR Lucknow, and various reputed institutions across India.

Study Centre for Micro Biology

This study centre was established in the year 2011 to provide theoretical, practical, and research facilities in various fields of Microbiology such as Medical Microbiology, Industrial Microbiology, Environmental Microbiology, etc.

Study Centre for Bio-Chemistry

The study centre for Bio-chemistry offers BSc and MSc Programmes in Bio-chemistry owing to the growing demand of students of this region. The centre has modern instruments and lab for quality research, teaching and learning in the field of Bio-chemistry. Our students are well placed in the reputed research centres of the country.

However, its name was changed to the 'Department of Mathematical Sciences' in April 1999. Initially, Prof. R. B. Misra (Professor & Head), Dr. C. K. Sharma (Reader), Dr. N. P. Singh, and Dr. J. P. Singh (Lecturers) joined as faculty members in 1985. In 1989, Dr. R. N. Singh joined as a lecturer. Dr. (Mrs.) Kavita Shrivastava and Dr. Akhileshwar Prasad were appointed as



lecturers in 1994 and 1996, respectively. Prof. R. B. Misra served as the Vice-Chancellor of Avadh University, Faizabad during 1989-92. Prof. C. K. Sharma served as the acting Vice-Chancellor of Awadhesh Pratap Singh University, Rewa in 2003.

The department offers M.Sc. and Ph.D. Programmes in Mathematics since its beginning. B.Sc. (Honors) mathematics Programme commenced from the session 2023-24. Currently, around one hundred fifty students are enrolled in the department. The department has made significant research contributions in Differential Geometry, collaborate with various research institutions across the country. Researchers from the department regularly visit and the National Board for Higher Mathematics, Mumbai. Faculty members have published approximately 250 research with high impact factors. Department of Physics

Rewa, located in the near-equatorial region, holds significant potential for recording and analyzing space data, crucial for Space Science and particularly Space Weather. Recognizing this, A.P.S. University, Rewa took the initiative to launch research and teaching activities in this important field of Science and Technology. With approval from the University Grants Commission, New Delhi during the first phase of the IV plan in 1975, the Vikram Space Physics Center was established on the university premises. The 18NM64 Super Neutron Monitor facility was set up under the leadership of Late Prof. S.P. Agrawal, a Ph.D. student of



the renowned scientist Prof. U.R. Rao, to record and analyze space data. This center evolved over time, eventually transforming into the full-fledged Physics Department in 1982.

Late Prof. R.L. Singh, Prof. S.K. Nigam, Prof. D.P. Tiwari, and Dr. V.N. Pandey joined the department to mentor aspiring students. Notably, Prof. S.P. Agrawal and Prof. S.K. Nigam served as acting Vice-Chancellors of the university, and Prof. R.L. Singh served as Vice-Chancellor of G.G.D. University, Bilaspur. With the addition of Prof. A.P. Mishra and Prof. S.L. Agrawal to the department in 1990, research activities flourished in the fields of Space Science and Materials Science, respectively. The department offers BSc Honors (Physics), MSc (Physics), and PhD (Physics) Programmes. We are launching BSc (Digital Electronics Opergramme from this academic year.

In the XI five-year plan, the department acquired advanced instruments such as Powder XRD and SEM. It continues to offer MSc Physics and PhD Physics Programmes. Since its inception, over 120 students have been awarded PhD degrees, and a considerable number of students are currently engaged in the PhD Programme. The department has produced around 400 research publications over the last four decades with the help of its existing facilities.

The department has organized several national and regional seminars and workshops. It has collaborated with number of NGOs such as Red Cross Rewa, Chinmay Seva Trust, and Laxmanpur Rewa, Sidhi. "Field education in Soc Work is a component of social work education programs where students learn to practice social work through educationally focused service experiences in agency and community settings." However, the social work studer and teachers actively engage in organizing camps and awareness programs in adopted villages by the University. \top National Child Labor Project was conducted by the department twice.

The PG Diploma in Guidance & Counseling (PGDGC) students undergo internships under the guidance psychiatrists, while MSW and MBA (IR&PM) students receive training in various industries and organizations. Teachers and students (acting as counselors) are actively involved in providing counseling to the students in the campus as and when required and to other clients with psychological disorders.



Study Centre for Industrial Relations & Personnel Management

The Study Centre for Industrial Relations & Personnel Management was established in 1998, introducing a joboriented PG Diploma Programme in Industrial Relations & Personnel Management as a self-financing professional program aimed at preparing youth in the region for employment in industrial and commercial organizations within the field. Later, the program was upgraded to an MBA (Industrial Relations & Personnel Management) Programme. The program structure follows the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), emphasizing understanding human behavior and its modification to enhance personnel and organizational productivity.

Our centre boasts excellent infrastructure and experienced faculty to facilitate learning. We regularly invite eminent speakers from industry and academia to enlighten students about their areas of expertise. Educational tours are organized to provide practical exposure to students. A management festival, "Aarohan," is held regularly to apply management concepts practically and promote experiential learning. The festival features over 20 academic, fine arts, cultural, and sports events. Most of our students have secured placements in corporate sector and various other walks of life.

Study Centre for Social Work

The idea of launching the Master of Social Work Programme to commemorate the 125th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi took shape in 1995 under the dynamic leadership of the then Vice-Chancellor, Prof. J.S. Rathore. The department aims to equip students with scientific knowledge, technical skills, and values necessary for various interventionist roles. The MSW programme is a two-year (four-semester) course designed to provide students with theoretical insights and practical skills for effective work in the fields of social welfare and social services. The study centre has organized numerous seminars, workshops, invited talks, and exhibitions on social issues and the role of NGOs in addressing them. We regularly conduct field visits to hospitals, old age homes, nearby villages, and localities to provide social services to those in need.

Study Centre for Yoga

This center was established in collaboration with Kaiwalya Dham Yoga Training Centre, Lonavala, to promote awareness about yoga in the region. In addition to offering regular PG Programs in Yoga, the center organizes yoga competitions annually. World Yoga Day is celebrated extensively on the university campus every year. Students from this center have participated in numerous yoga events and competitions, enhancing the center's reputation through their performances.



Department of Physical Education & Sports Science

The Department of Physical Education and Sports Science was established in 1968 to organize physical education and sports activities in the University. The Department has a distinct identity of its own. We offerBPEd (2 years) 1988, MPEd(02Years) 1994, BPES (3 years) 2010, MPES (2 years) 2023, and PhD Programmes.

The department manages the university stadium and gymnasium, featuring a viewers' gallery accommodating approximately 10,000 spectators, along with two pavilions and a modern gymnasium. The Directorate of University Sports oversees the teaching department. The stadium's physical exercise infrastructure has been recognized by the BCCI, which has selected our venue for Ranji and Vizzy trophy matches.

Over 20 students secured positions as sports officers in higher education college services through MPPSC, while 8 students have been appointed

as lecturers at district institutes of education training via UPPSC. Additionally, 5 students were selected in UP ϵ services during 2018-19.

The students of the department have actively participated in National, All India, and East Zone inter-university events. Apart from cricket, the stadium supports tracks for Hockey, Handball, Football, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Athle S. Wrestling, Weightlifting, Judo, Powerlifting, Table Tennis and Boxing.

All India Women's Cricket and Women's Khokho Inter University Tournaments were organized by the department in the session 2023-24. All-India Circle Style Kabaddi (Men) and East Zone Inter-University Cricket (Women), State Inter-University Cricket were organized during the sessions of 2019-2020, 2021-22 and 2022-23. In the session of 2021-2022, the department organized All to discontinuous cricket 2022, the department organized All-India Circle Style Kabaddi (Women) and East Zone Inter-University Cricket (Women). Subsequently, in 2022-2023, we hosted East Zone Inter-University Chess (Men), University Cricket (Women), and East Zone Inter-University Badminton (Men) competitions. The women's team of university cricket successfully qualified for the All Land and the competition of t university cricket successfully qualified for the All-India Inter-University Cricket (Women) tournament in 2022-23.





CENTRAL FACILITIES

Central Library

The University has a Central Library with a vast collection of books and journals. The library includes an e-Library Section providing access to numerous online journals, books, and publications for students, research scholars, and faculty members. Efforts are ongoing to regularly acquire standard publications. Additionally, each teaching department maintains its own departmental library.

University Publications

The university has two regular publications; Pratibimb& Vindhya Bharti. Pratibimb is a quarterly Newsletter while Vindhya Bharti is an annual multi-disciplinary Research Journal.

Hostel Facility

The university campus has one hostel each for boys and girls studying in the University Teaching Departments. The availability of seats is limited and the quota is allotted to every department. Interested candidates apply for accommodation in the hostel in the prescribed form through proper channel.

University Guest House

University has a well-furnished Guest House in the campus. The accommodation and catering is provided to the guests of the university at a nominal cost.

University Stadium & Sports

The University Stadium is centrally located in the city. It has facilities for Cricket, Volleyball, Basketball, Kho Kho, Kabbadi and Wrestling. There is a football ground, Gymnasium Hall & Yoga Hall in the main Campus. Every year university's teams participate in various inter-university games and sports competitions like athletics, basketball, badminton, chess, cricket, khokho, hockey, hand ball, volley ball, wrestling, judo, karate etc. Thedesired information regarding eligibility, selections and schedules can be taken from the Department of Physical Education & Sports.

University Auditorium
